Directions and Maps

Directions to John Hunt Park:

From I-565, go south (right) on Memorial Parkway (US 231) to Airport Road exit. Go west (right) on Airport Road about ½ mile and turn left into John Hunt Park, take the first left toward the sand volleyball complex. Parking is on the right through the metal gates.

Parking:

Parking is located across from the sand volleyball courts. Vehicles are NOT allowed on the course.

Team Tents in Designated Area:

Team tents may be set up on the grass near the finish line or near the parking lot. Please bring a trash bag to collect your trash under and around your tent upon departure. Spectators will want to bring chairs. Spectators can enjoy views of the start, finish, mile 1, and mile 2 from the same location near the finish line.

Restrooms:

Restrooms are available on site.

Running Attire:

Runners should arrive in running uniforms. Team members should wear matching uniform shirts/singlets/or t-shirts when running. There is not an area for dressing. Shorts inseams according to current ACAA standards. Running shoes or running spikes are appropriate for this course.

Food Options:

Food on Race Day:

- 1. Host team will offer cups of water for runners at the finish line. Teams may fill coolers at the finish line from the potable in-ground faucet.
- 2. Runners should bring their own water, Gatorade, etc.
- 3. Grocery stores and restaurants are within 1-2 miles driving distance.

First Aid:

A defibrillator and basic first aid kit will be located at the finish line. However, coaches are responsible for their own runners' safety.

Frequently Asked Questions:

How many runners are on a team?

For the ACAA Championship, a team may have as many runners as you like, but only the top four finishers will count for the team/division point total. Each division race will have 3 individual winners (1st, 2nd, 3rd) and 3 team winners (1st,2nd,3rd).

How are winners determined?

Individual winners will be determined by timing. Team winners will be determined by order of finish of team members. The lowest team score wins. All questions regarding scoring should be directed to the race director or rules coordinator. See contact information above for cell numbers.

Who is eligible?

- Member and associate schools in the Alabama Christian Athletic Association.
- 6th graders-eligible for Jr. High division only.
- 7th-9th graders-eligible for Jr. High or Sr. High but may not compete in both.
- 10th-12th graders -eligible for Varsity division only.
- Runners may only register for one race.
- Jr. High Eligibility-those who turn 16 on or after August 1 of the current year.
- Varsity Eligibility-those who turn 19 on or after August 1 of the current year.
- 4 runners scored for team awards. Any runner may compete for individual awards.
